Livewire Remote & SSL C200

LiveWire Remote records concerts and awards shows for television, as well as live radio broadcasts, live albums, and orchestral film soundtracks. LiveWire has recorded dozens of international artists, including U2, AC/DC, Celine Dion, Oscar Peterson, Ozzy Osbourne, Stevie Ray Vaughan, 50 Cent, The Rolling Stones, Melissa Etheridge, Joni Mitchell, Bryan Adams, Leonard Cohen, Van Halen, Emmylou Harris, R.E.M, The Police, Neil Young, Ray Charles, Garth Brooks, Blues Brothers 2000 soundtrack, Annie Lennox, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Coldplay and Lenny Kravitz.

The LiveWire mobile is a 32' long air-ride trailer, with a tape room, control room, and maintenance room. The truck is equipped for full 5.1 surround sound monitoring. One side expands to give an additional four feet of width, resulting in a 16' x 12' control room, designed by Pilchner-Schoustal, one of North America's top studio design firms.

LiveWire has just installed a new SSL C200 digital console in the mobile. It has 96 inputs on banks of 32 faders, 5.1 surround sound bussing, and snapshot recall of all parameters. 72 SSL mic pre's feed the console via a 1000' fibre optic snake and can provide up to 96 tracks of Protools HD backed up by 96 tracks of Tascam X-48 on Firewire drives.

Owner/engineer Doug has engineered over 3000 remotes since 1975, and has received platinum CD's for albums by Blue Rodeo and Moxy Fruvous. He has been nominated for a Gemini Award for Best Sound in a TV Variety Special nine times, and won that award in 2003.

Steve Zaretsky, Vice President Broadcast Sales, and Don Wershba, Senior VP for Solid State Logic, Inc. will also be on hand to answer questions.
